Other Opportunities

Office Helper: Support ABC staff by answering phones, data entry, filing, mailing, and doing other clerical work. This is an ongoing opportunity offering a flexible schedule.

Special Skills: Volunteers with special skills, such as sign language interpretation or CPR/First Aid certification, are always needed at ABC.

Group Projects
